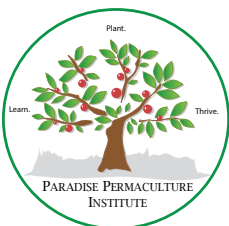

From fruit harvest to extraction and storage of seeds, we'll cover more basics than last year. **Cheryl Moore-Gough:** New topics this year include "Talks" on Growing Plants for Seed and Harvesting; and Cleaning Seed and Seed Storage. Cheryl Moore-Gough is currently Adjunct Assistant Professor in horticulture at MSU, where she teaches Vegetable Production. Additionally, she co-authored 5 books with her late husband and recently on her own released **The Montana Gardener's Companion Second Edition**. Her next book, **Rocky Mountain Vegetable Gardening Guide** is scheduled to be released in February of 2016. Together, they wrote in 2011 *The Complete Guide to Saving Seeds*. Cheryl is also the technical horticulture editor for *Rocky Mountain Gardening Magazine*. **Michele Evans:** Michele will provide hands-on experience with seeds, practical information for growing seed and bring real growing examples. Michele Evans is a Montana Master Gardener Level 2 and a bio-intensive instructor working with Ecology Action, a non-profit working in 145 countries teaching nutrition intervention by showing people how to grow all their food and soil.
