Harvest tips for frosty weather:

If you anticipate a frost, pull the whole plant, and hang it by the roots upside down in a cool dry space until pods turn brown.

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

 Let pods dry and turn brown before harvesting, about four weeks past the fresh eating stage.



2. Open pods by hand or, if working with large amounts, place between tarp sheets and dance on them!



 Place DRY seeds in envelope or jar; LABEL with seed variety & year; store in cool, dark, dry location.** Plant in spring!

> **These seeds will stay viable for at least 3-5 years.

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2. Open pods by hand or, if working with large amounts, place between tarp sheets and dance on them!

- Thresh and winnow as needed.
 Use a screen and/or a little wind to separate seeds from chaff.
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
